SNAP helps over 458,000 working families in New York stretch their monthly food budgets and afford nutritious foods. They also help the local economy—every dollar spent in SNAP generates \$1.79 in revenue for local grocers, bodegas, and farmers' markets.

The **Nutrition Outreach and Education Program (NOEP)** offers free prescreenings to see if you may be eligible for SNAP. NOEP Coordinators guide you through the entire application process, including gathering paperwork, filling out the application, and sending it in. They can even help you apply online. It's free and confidential.

In addition, did you know your child could be eligible for free or reduced price meals at school if you receive SNAP benefits?
