INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM

The Board of Education is committed to the optimization of education through application of information technology tools. The Board recognizes the value of computers, electronic devices and computer-related information technology in pursuit of the district's educational mission and goals. It is the intent of the Board that information technology resources be utilized in district classrooms and curriculum to enhance the teaching & learning experience of students, teachers and staff.

All users of the district's computer network and the Internet must understand that use is a privilege, not a right, and that use entails responsibility.

The Board directs the Superintendent of Schools to establish procedures and regulations governing the use and security of the district's information technology resources.

The Board also directs the Superintendent to submit a comprehensive technology plan to address the utilization of the district's information technology resources including but not limited to software applications, online databases, electronic bulletin boards and electronic mail in furtherance of the district's educational mission and goals for the Board's approval. This plan shall thereafter be revised as necessary to reflect changes in the district's information technology needs.

Failure to comply with district policies and regulations addressing use of information technology may result in disciplinary action.
