Senior Privileges

The following privileges will begin for Seniors on <u>Tuesday, October 10<sup>th</sup></u>.



## **EXPECTATIONS**

- 1) <u>Academics</u> Be in good academic standing defined as not failing any scheduled classes.
- <u>Attendance</u> not have hit the 9/18 threshold for daily absences for a semester course and/or a full year course.
- 3) <u>Behavior</u> If seniors engage in unsafe, disrespectful and/or irresponsible behavior(s) you will lose your senior privileges until further notice. It is in your best interest to be respectful and patient with Mrs. Roberts and Mrs. Tamer in the main office when signing in or out of the school building.
- 4) Permission forms must be signed by eligible seniors AND the parent/guardian BEFORE privileges can begin.

## PRIVILEGES

- Eligible seniors who have an academic study hall 1<sup>st</sup> period will be allowed to arrive to school late without penalty. You must arrive on time for your scheduled academic class.
- 2) Eligible seniors who have an academic study hall 9<sup>th</sup> period will be allowed to leave school early without penalty.
- 3) LUNCH Eligible seniors will be allowed to remain in the cafeteria for their entire lunch period.
- 4) Eligible Seniors may leave campus for lunch or to pick up lunch. However, all food items MUST BE CONSUMED prior to the next period class. Under no circumstances are seniors allowed to leave campus, pick up food and consume it during their academic classes. Seniors who elect to leave campus must leave the premises and enter the school building immediately upon returning to campus. Loitering and/or "hanging out" in vehicles or in the school parking lot is prohibited.
- 5) Only eligible Seniors who DO NOT have a scheduled lunch will be permitted to leave campus during a study hall for lunch or to pick up lunch. Mrs. Roberts and Mrs. Tamer have a list of those eligible students. Only those students will be allowed to leave during an academic study hall that is not scheduled at the beginning or the end of the day.
- 6) Eligible Seniors who are seated in the senior section of the cafeteria will be permitted to use their cell phones during academic study halls.
- Eligible seniors will be allowed to leave school 9<sup>th</sup> period (at the discretion of the teacher) 3 minutes early.
- 8) Weather permitting, eligible seniors will be allowed to sit/eat/visit outside in the adjacent area of the senior section of the cafeteria (paved section).
